Guest Speaker – Bruce Francis

Bruce Colin Francis is a former Australian cricketer who played three Tests on the 1972 Australian tour of England as an opening batsman. He also played the first two “Tests”, before breaking his hand, against the World XI which replaced the scheduled South African tour in 1971-72.

In his book, ‘The Complete Who’s Who of Test Cricketers’, Christopher Martin-Jenkins said of Bruce “A genial and intelligent man, an economics graduate of Sydney University, and a strapping right-handed opening batsman who loved to attack. Bruce Francis was a popular cricketer with both players and spectators. If he got going at the start of an innings, there was no likelihood of dull cricket for he was a handsome striker of the ball, especially to the on-side and with his burly strength the lofted straight drive was often brought into use against even the fastest bowlers.

Coming to England in 1970 to play for Accrington in the Lancashire league, he scored more runs in the season than anyone in history of the League/Worsley Cup. In 1971 he scored 1578 runs including four centuries for Essex in the county championship, which were more runs than any first-year player in Essex’s history. Two of those centuries were before lunch.

In 1973 he scored 1384 runs for Essex with four centuries. Francis played a number of remarkable innings that year but the one against Yorkshire stands out. He scored 188 not out in the team total of 6 for 267 declared, which is still one of the highest percentages in first class cricket by a batsman in a team scoring over 200. Bruce was 114 not out when the fifth wicket fell at 143.

Francis toured South Africa in 1973 with an international team which included Tony Greig, Younis Ahmed, Brian Close, John Edrich, John Snow, John Gleeson, John Lever and Max Walker. In the first match against Western Province at Newlands, Francis scored 194 in 223 minutes, which included 109 in the session before lunch. He and England star John Edrich put on 202 in 147 minutes for the second wicket. The first hundred partnership came up in 82 minutes and Edrich’s contribution was 26. Edrich also contributed 26 of the second hundred partnership which came up in 65 minutes.

Francis gave cricket away after this tour aged just 25 to put his Economics degree to work. He managed Tony Greig’s affairs for many years. He negotiated Tony’s contract to play WSC and Tony’s life-long contract to work for Packer. He was best man at Tony’s second marriage.

In his book: ‘Cricket Outlaws: Inside Kerry Packer’s Revolution”, author and one of four WSC shareholders Austin Robertson said: “Bruce (Mule) Francis is a smart guy, as sharp as anyone I came across in my WSC adventure. He might not have had the most illustrious Test career but his contribution to Aussie cricket, and WSC’s part in it in particular went far beyond the 52 runs he made under the baggy green. Mule also became close to Kerry and his family, giving young James private cricket coaching [for 10 years], he was privy to some of the most delicate issues surrounding WSC.”

Francis organised the Kim Hughes led South African rebel tours in the mid-eighties. And to prove he is a jack of all trades, Rugby Union supremo Dr Danny Craven employed Bruce as his personal adviser for four years. Bruce has also worked off and on as a writer and researcher for 30 years for Alan Jones. And more recently, no one in Australia knows more about the Essendon saga than Bruce. He has spent more than 15,000 hours on the issue and has written more than a million words.
