Guest Speaker – Bruce Francis

Bruce Colin Francis is a former Australian cricketer who played three Tests on the 1972 Australian tour of England as an opening batsman. He also played the first two “Tests”, before breaking his hand, against the World XI which replaced the scheduled South African tour in 1971-72.

In his book, ‘The Complete Who’s Who of Test Cricketers’, Christopher Martin-Jenkins said of Bruce “A genial and intelligent man, an economics graduate of Sydney University, and a strapping right-handed opening batsman who loved to attack. Bruce Francis was a popular cricketer with both players and spectators. If he got going at the start of an innings, there was no likelihood of dull cricket for he was a handsome striker of the ball, especially to the on-side and with his burly strength the lofted straight drive was often brought into use against even the fastest bowlers.



Francis toured South Africa in 1973 with an international team which included Tony Greig, Younis Ahmed, Brian Close, John Edrich, John Snow, John Gleeson, John Lever and Max Walker. In the first match against Western Province at Newlands, Francis scored 194 in 223 minutes, which included 109 in the session before lunch. He and Edrich put on 202 in 147 minutes for the second wicket.

In his book: ‘Cricket Outlaws: Inside Kerry Packer’s Revolution’, author and one of four WSC shareholders Austin Robertson said: “Bruce (Mule) Francis is a smart guy, as sharp as anyone I came across in my WSC adventure. He might not have had the most illustrious Test career but his contribution to Aussie cricket, and WSC’s part in it in particular went far beyond the 52 runs he made under the baggy green. Mule also became close to Kerry and his family, giving young James private cricket coaching [for 10 years], he was privy to some of the most delicate issues surrounding WSC.”

Guest Speaker – Greg Ritchie

Greg Ritchie also known as “Fat Cat” is a former Australian cricket who played 30 Tests and 44 ODIs and over 240 matches for Queensland. A beefy middle-order batsman with a range of silken strokes, Ritchie made a century in only his second Test, in Pakistan – 106*, but only two more in 28 further matches.

After making his debut on the 1982-82 tour of Pakistan, he was unable to force his way into the Australian team over the 1982-83 and 1983-84 summers but was selected on the 1984 tours of the West Indies and India. He became a fixture in the middle order between 1985 and 1987 which included the 1985 Ashes tour where he scored his highest score of 146 at Nottingham, 1986 tours of New Zealand and India and the 1986-1987 Ashes Series.



His ample proportions probably told against him when a new austerity took hold in Australian cricket as it began to rebuild during the late 1980s, and liteness in the field became important. It was a shame, because he was an aesthetically appealing cricketer, with a lovely straight-drive. He continued to score heavily for Queensland.

Ritchie has enjoyed a successful post-cricket career in the media, including his well-known role as Mahatma Cote on Channel Nine and as a commentator on the PGA Tour.
